ABSTRACT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTION

PLEASE READ THIS THOROUGHLY BEFORE PREPARING YOUR ABSTRACT

1. Only abstracts written in English will be accepted.
2. The abstract should contain no more than 500 words. Please upload the pdf file.
3. CAPITALIZE the entire title and UNDERLINE the name of author who will present the paper. Abbreviations must not be used in the title. After the title, list the author's names and institutional affiliations; please OMIT degrees, titles, institutional appointments, address and zip code. The text should be typed using single spacing. Do not indent the title and each paragraph.
4. An author cannot present more than **two (2) papers**; that is, an author cannot secure the inclusion of more than two papers on the program. Any additional papers will not be included in the program.
5. To guarantee the placement of a paper on the conference program, one author needs to register AND pay conference registration fees.
6. The abstract will be published in the proceedings after the registration is complete.
7. Please choose one subject that is most relevant to your research topic to help steer your paper into the most appropriate session. Subjects include:
